## New cardiovascular center completed for UCSD

DPR Construction has announced it has completed construction of the University of California, San Diego's \$227 million Sulpizio Family Cardiovascular Center.

Construction began in May 2008 on the 127,000-square-foot facility that has 76-patient bed hospital with 22 daybeds for pre- and post-procedure care, 12 intensive care beds, 15 intermediate care beds and 27 acute care beds.

The Sulpizio Family Cardiovascular Center also features an emergency department with four large operating rooms, specifically designed for heart surgery; 14 smaller treatment rooms; and an area for heart-imaging services, such as multi-slice CT scanning.

DPR said the 127,000-square-foot Sulpizio Family Cardiovascular Center was finished under budget and ahead of schedule.
