Harry enjoyed burgers and brew with three friends Friday night in Coronado at McP's Irish Pub and Grill. "He was very personable. He was a nice guy, very low-key," McP's Irish Pub and Grill bar manager Ted Taylor told People.com.

The waitress who served Harry and his crew, Leah Bentley, 32, told the Daily Mail: "Harry and his

friends were really nice. It took me a minute before I realized who he was. I bantered with him and tried to treat him like any other customer. He and his friends were very good-looking and were nice tippers."

The next night, the prince partied at the Ivy Nightclub in the Andaz San Diego hotel until closing, Channel 7/39 reported. The 27-year-old royal kicked back with 20 friends — and some Absolut vodka, Red Bull and beer, The New York Daily News says.
